## Financial Aid Process

To be eligible for Federal, State and most Institutional aid, each student must complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

### Create

#### Your FSA ID

You will need an FSA ID as your electronic signature for the FAFSA. If you are an undergraduate, dependent student, your parents will need their own FSA ID. You can apply online at [studentaid.gov/fsa-id](https://studentaid.gov/fsa-id).

### File

#### Your FAFSA

You must complete a FAFSA at [fafsa.ed.gov](https://fafsa.ed.gov) each academic year. The FAFSA opens October 1st. UNCG's priority filing date is January 15 and our school code is 002976.

### Receive

#### Your Award Notice

Once your file is complete, we will send an award notification email in early spring with instructions on viewing your award online through UNCGenie ([ssb.uncg.edu](https://ssb.uncg.edu)).

### Accept

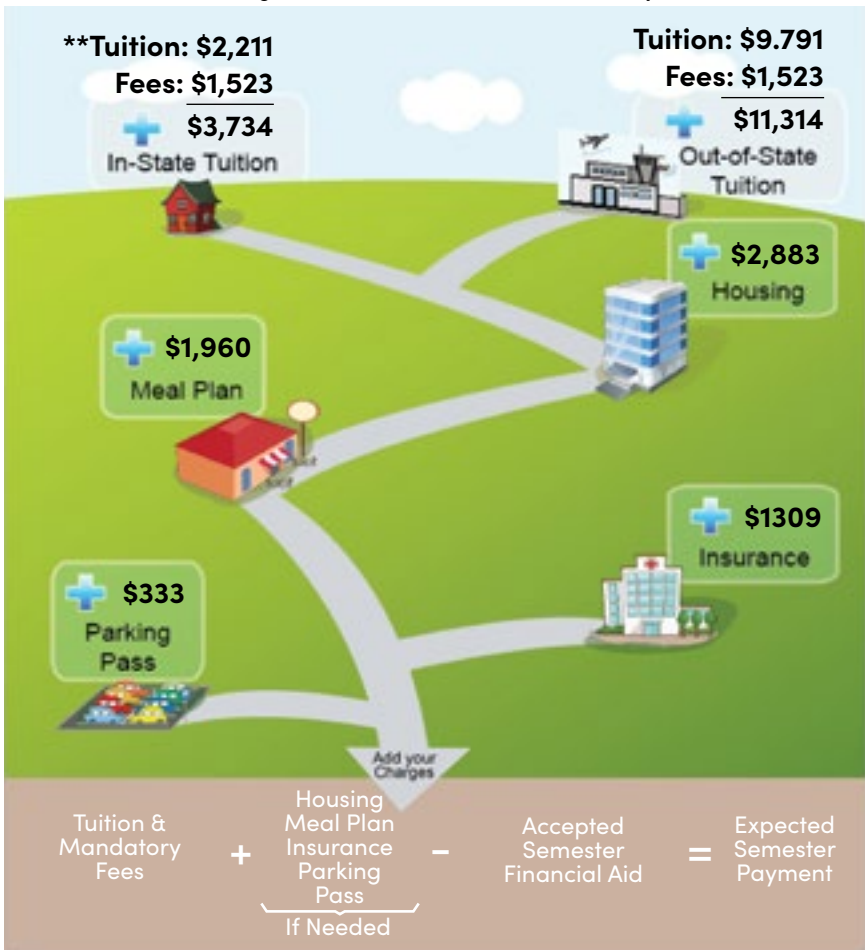
#### Your Award
