

Baccalaureate Degree Plan (BDP)
Associate in Arts (AA) to BA Dance Studies - Dance Studies Concentration

The sequence below is contingent on completion of the AA degree from a college in the North Carolina Community College System (NCCCS). It represents one way in which the program of study can be completed. Following the BDP does not guarantee admission to UNCG or guarantee an AA or BA degree will be conferred. Students should seek academic advising to determine the best course of study to meet educational goals and degree requirements. The Bachelor of Arts in Dance, Dance Studies concentration requires a minimum of 120 semester hours (sh). UNCG requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA for graduation. Dance requires an overall 2.50 or higher GPA in courses taken at UNCG (3.0 or higher GPA for Dance Education concentration). A minimum of 50 credit hours in DCE courses is required for the program.

Full admission to the School of Dance is a two-step process involving a successful live dance audition, as well as acceptance into the University by the Office of Undergraduate Admissions. Acceptance to the University prior to your dance audition is not a requirement, though you are strongly encouraged to submit an application to the

Office of Undergraduate Admissions prior to your audition. The School of Dance holds auditions once per semester. Auditions are limited to 50 applicants, and may close early.
