

Baccalaureate Degree Plan (BDP)
Associate of Applied Science (AAS) – RN to BSN

The sequence below is contingent on completion of the AAS in nursing from a college in the North Carolina Community College System (NCCCS). It represents one way in which the program of study can be completed. Following the BDP does not guarantee admission to UNCG or guarantee an AAS or BS degree will be conferred. Students should seek academic advising to determine the best course of study to meet educational goals and degree requirements. [Refer to the University Admissions website for more information on admission and transfer of credits.](#) *NOTE: Credit will only be awarded for transferable courses for which a grade of C (2.0) or better is earned.*

Pages 1 and 2 reflect the credits to be completed at a NC Community College per the Uniform Articulation Agreement, effective Fall 2015.

Eligibility for the Uniform Articulation Agreement, a potential student must:

- Enter a NC Community College Nursing program on or after Fall Semester, 2015
- Earn an Associate Degree in Nursing at a NC Community College with a GPA of at least 2.0
- Earn a C or better in all courses included in the first three blocks of the plan.
- Be licensed as an RN prior to applying to the RN to BSN program.

Pages 3 and 4 reflect the academic plan of study, following completion of the AAS and transfer to UNCG.

This BDP is based upon full-time enrollment (12 or more hours) each semester.
