The Bachelor of Science in Public Health Education: Health Studies Online concentration requires a minimum of 120 semester hours (sh). UNCG requires a minimum 2.0 overall GPA for graduation.

Minimum criteria for admission to the Health Studies Online Education Concentration include:

- 1. Overall grade point average of 2.50 or higher
- 2. A grade of C (2.0) or better in each of the prerequisite health-related courses listed below or their equivalent. Prerequisite courses may be repeated only one time to earn the minimum required grade or better.
  - a. HEA 213 or BIO 271 & 271L or BIO 277 & 277L or KIN 291 & KIN 291L or KIN 292 & KIN 292L; CST 105 or CST 341; ENG 101; MAT 115 or STA 108; PSY 121 or SOC 101; ISM 110
- 3. HEA courses A grade of C (2.0) or higher in any completed HEA courses (including transferred HEA courses).
