

Transfer Guide for Nursing 2Plus Students

Associate in Applied Science (AAS) in Nursing or Associate Degree Nursing (ADN)

Refer to UNCG's admissions website for more information on admission and transfer of credits. Credit will only be awarded for transferable courses for which a grade of C or better is earned. Refer to the NC Transfer Course List for full listing of courses by designation – UGETC, CAA GEN ED, Pre-Major/Elective.

15 SHCs of courses should be selected from courses classified as general education within the CAA. The following are the recommended courses for the most efficient transfer to UNCG. Other selections may be made from the AAS/ADN curriculums, but we recommend checking the <u>transfer credit planner</u> to see if those other options are available for transfer.

Students will be required to complete 49 hours of technical major credits to earn their AAS degree. Most courses required in the Nursing curriculum do not transfer directly to UNCG. However, the following courses that may or may not contribute to their Associate Degree may be a benefit to the student once they transfer to UNCG.

The following guide shows the other credits that can be transferred by Nursing 2plus Students who have completed their applicable Associate Degree. <u>In addition to these hours, these students will also have their MAC General Education requirements satisfied.</u>

Additional Elective Hours	0-35	NUR 000



A maximum of 64 hours will transfer from across all 2-year (Community College) institutions. Duplicate equivalencies up to the maximum may be converted to electives. Credits will be reallocated up to the maximum for the greatest benefit of the student if more than 64 transferable hours are found among the student's 2-year coursework. Only grades of C (2.0) or higher are eligible for transfer to UNCG.
