This application is a request for a review of special circumstances that you believe may change your financial aid eligibility.

Professional Judgment refers to the school’s authority to make adjustments to the data elements reported on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) so that the Department of Education can recalculate the Student Aid Index (SAI). The SAI is the FAFSA-generated number that the school uses to determine a student’s eligibility for need based financial aid. The school does not have the authority to make direct adjustments to the SAI and can only change data elements that may change the SAI.

The Professional Judgment process usually takes around 2 weeks once all needed documentation is submitted. If the committee reviewing your application requires further information, the student’s financial aid requirements will be updated in their UNCGenie account and an email will be sent to the student’s UNCG email address.

Please Note:

Even if the Professional Judgment Process results in a lower SAI, the changes may not be enough to generate eligibility for need-based financial aid or an increase in the financial aid award.

Submitting a Professional Judgment application does **NOT** extend payment deadlines. You must pay your semester bill on time to ensure that your registration is not canceled.

A denial does not mean that the UNCG Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships disbelieves a situation, only that no helpful change could be made using the information provided OR that the information could not replace any of the answers on the FAFSA.

- Detailed letter of explanation regarding your current situation with handwritten signature: may use 2nd page of this form
- Professional Judgment Application Form with handwritten signatures: 1st page of this form
- Copy of most recent (2023 or 2024) IRS Tax Return Transcript (<https://www.irs.gov/individuals/get-transcript>)
- Copies of most recent 2024 paystub(s) for ALL jobs worked that year
